Evening Activities

Special presentations are planned on a variety of topics related to improving your play. Evening activities include swimming, billiards, ping pong, and a movie night. Sherman Hall also features a piano and a computer lounge.

Instructional Sessions

There is a special emphasis on the short game during the academy. Instruction will be enhanced with drills and games for putting, chipping, pitching and bunker play. On course play and competitions will also reinforce instructional sessions. Course management and rules scenarios will be addressed during the rounds.

Tournament Day

Students will have the opportunity to apply what they have learned during the camp while participating in the camp-ending tournament. Parents are invited to come out early and watch. Awards and picnic will follow play.



MEET THE COACHES...

RENEE SLONE

U of I Head
Women's Golf Coach
Assistant Academy Director

Now in her third season as head women's coach, Slone has already led the Illini to a new 54 hole school record and their first multiple win season since 2002-03. The Illini boast their first All Big Ten selection in 13 years under Slone. She served as the assistant coach at both the U of I and Bradley University following her 8 year professional playing career on the Futures, Asian and LPGA Tours. A 3-time All-American for the Illini, Slone was named the College Player of the Year by both the National Golf Coaches Association and Golfweek following her record setting senior season which included 8 individual victories. She was inducted into the NGCA Players Hall of Fame in 2005.

Rick Slone is in his third year as the assistant women's golf coach. Slone has been a Class A PGA Member for almost 15 years and has served as the Director of Golf/Head Golf Professional at clubs in South Carolina, Georgia and North Carolina. He developed the PGA recognized Clubs in the Classroom program that has introduced the game of golf to thousands of elementary school children. He has instructed numerous junior players who have earned college scholarships and enjoyed professional playing careers.



FACILITIES



Instruction will take place at the University of Illinois Orange and Blue Golf Courses and practice facilities. Campers will also have access to the short game outdoor teaching center used exclusively by the U of I men's and women's teams. The center features two 7000-square foot greens, one for putting and the other for chipping, pitching and full shots as well as three different bunkers. This area was designed for players to practice every type of golf shot from inside 130 yards.

Campers will also have access to the Demirjian Golf Facility, one of the nation's premier indoor practice facilities. The building includes a 7700-square foot putting, chipping and pitching area and six heated bays that open onto an outdoor driving range. Two of the hitting bays contain state-of-the-art video analysis equipment.

ACCOMMODATIONS



Sherman Hall

Located just blocks from Campus Town and the Quad, Sherman Hall is right in the heart of campus. It consists of one high-rise building and one low-rise building joined by a common lobby. Each room is air conditioned and contains a micro-fridge (a small microwave and refrigerator combination). Semi-private (shared) bathrooms are adjacent to each room. Residents share a bath with one or two other people.
