### DATES

### COST

\$425 per camper—includes housing, meals, refreshments, video, instruction, and golf.

### REFUND POLICY

\$50 application processing fee will be charged for all refunds.

### AGE LIMIT

Open to any female junior golfer who has reached her 10th birthday through high school graduation.

### HOUSING

All campers will be housed in dormitories on the Auburn University campus. There will be constant supervision by qualified staff.

### MEALS

Meals will be served daily at an Auburn University dining hall, the golf course and other Auburn FUN spots.

### GOLF FACILITIES

The Auburn Junior Girls Golf Camp instruction and activities will be held at the *Auburn University Club* and the *Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility*. The Facility is home to both AU Golf Team's and is equipped with covered hitting bays, video analysis, locker rooms and more. The *University Club* is host to an award winning short game area, driving range, and championship golf course.

### CHECK-IN

Check-in will be held from **1:00-2:30PM** on **Saturday, June 13, 2009**. All health forms will be required at this time. Upon acceptance of application you will receive a conformation letter of specific details and directions for check-in.

### CAMP STAFF

*Kim Evans* is in her 15<sup>th</sup> season as the head women's golf coach at Auburn University. She brings a vast knowledge of the game and true experience working with junior golfers. Evans led the Auburn Tigers to five SEC Championships in 1996, 2000, 2003, 2005, and 2006. She was also SEC coach of the year in 1996, 2001, 2002 and voted National Coach of the Year in 2002. Evans has coached collegiate golfers and worked with junior golfers for over 20 years. Evans served as the assistant men's golf coach at Georgia Tech and was Associate Director of the Atlanta Junior Golf Association from 1988-1994. She was awarded the PGA Georgia Junior Golf Leader award in 1992 and has been a member of the PGA National Junior Steering Committee.

*Courtney Trimble* has just completed her fourth season as the Auburn Tiger assistant under Kim Evans. Courtney is a 2002 graduate and 4 year letter winner from Auburn University. During Courtney's collegiate career at Auburn she was a 3- time All-Sec Team member and a 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-American in 2002. She returns to the Auburn golf program after playing the Futures Tour for 2 years and working as a teaching pro in Atlanta.
