**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FIRST  
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

***Florida Southern Retains Top Spot in D-II Poll***

NEW YORK, NY—The first *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the spring season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the March 9 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at [www.golfworld.com](http://www.golfworld.com).

Florida Southern remained the number one team in the poll, earning seven of the 10 first-place votes. The Lady Mocs opened the spring with a victory at the Tusculum/Kiawah Island Invitational, beating third-ranked Rollins by two strokes. It was Florida Southern's fourth victory of the 2008-09 season.

Nova Southeastern (No. 2) received the remaining three first-place votes. The Knights also won their first tournament of the spring season, the Braveheart Classic, where they defeated 10 Division I schools.

Grand Valley State (No. 4) and Tarleton State (No. 5) round out the top-five.

Northern Kentucky (No. 23), Chico State (No. 24) and Saint Martins (No. 25) moved into the top-25.
