***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF SECOND
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

Rollins Replaces Nova Southeastern as Top Team in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the September 26th issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Rollins takes over the top spot in the poll, despite earning only three of nine first-place votes. The Lady Tars finished fifth in the Princeton Invitational, a Division I tournament.

Rounding out the top-five are Florida Southern (No. 2), Nova Southeastern (No. 3), Tarleton State (No. 4) and California U. (Pa.) (No. 5).

California U. (Pa.) had the biggest jump, moving from No. 14 in the preseason poll to fifth in this week's poll. West Texas A&M (No. 22) and Central Oklahoma (No. 24) moved into the top-25.
