**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF  
SECOND WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

***Florida Southern Retains Top Spot***

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the October 5 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at [www.golfworld.com](http://www.golfworld.com).

Florida Southern remains the number one team, earning 13 of 16 first-place votes. The Mocs return all five starters from last year's NCAA championship team and started their fall with a victory at the Grand Canyon Invitational (Sept. 23-25). Rounding out the top five are Rollins (No. 2), Ferris State (No. 3), Grand Valley State (No. 4) and Barry (No. 5).

Tarleton State (No. 7) and Northeastern State (No. 10) have jumped into the top-ten, after being ranked Nos. 10 and 12, respectively, in the previous coaches' poll. Tarleton State has won its first three events this fall, including most recently a victory at the Lion Fall Invitational. Northeastern State has finished second in its first two tournaments of the fall: the Drury Deerfield Inn Regional Shootout and the Northeastern State Women's Classic.

New to the top-25 are Upper Iowa (No. 19), Northern Kentucky (No. 20) and Southern Indiana (No. 21). Upper Iowa grabbed a share of the title at the Concordia University Invitational, one of three top-five finishes this fall. Northern Kentucky finished second at the Screaming Eagle Invitational (Sept. 23-24) and just won the Midwest Shootout on Monday. Southern Indiana finished third at the Midwest Shootout and won the Illinois Wesleyan Fall Classic and Screaming Eagle Invitational earlier in the month.
