***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF SECOND
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

Nova Southeastern Retains Top Spot in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the November 9 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Nova Southeastern remained the number one team in the poll, earning 10 of the 12 first-place votes. The Sharks have won all three tournaments they have played in the fall, including two with primarily Division I competition. Most recently, they won their home event, the NSU-Shark Invitational, by one stroke.

Rounding out the top-five are Rollins (No. 2), Grand Valley State (No. 3), Florida Southern (No. 4) and Barry (No. 5).

Newberry (No. 9) and Nebraska-Omaha (No. 10) cracked the top-10, after being ranked Nos. 13 and T-15, respectively, in the previous coaches' poll.

Western Washington (No. 16), CSU-Monterey Bay (T-19), Sonoma State (T-19), Angelo State (No. 22), St. Leo (No. 23) and Central Oklahoma (No. 24) moved into the top-25.
