**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FOURTH AND FINAL  
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

***Florida Southern Remains Top Team in D-II Poll***

NEW YORK, NY—The fourth and final *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, can be viewed online now at [www.golfworld.com](http://www.golfworld.com). The polls will also appear in the Nov. 28 issue of *Golf World*.

Florida Southern has retained the number one spot in the poll, earning four of the nine first-place votes. The Lady Mocs finished the fall season with two wins, two second-place finishes and one third-place showing.

Nova Southeastern moved up to the number two spot, and received the other five first-place votes. The Sharks won their final two tournaments of the fall, the NSU Shark Invitational and the Ross Resorts Invitational.

Rounding out the top-five are Grand Valley State (No. 3), Tarleton State (No. 4) and California U. (Pa.) (No. 5).

Lynn (No. 6) and Barry (No. 8) cracked the top-10, after being ranked 14<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, respectively, in the previous coaches' poll. Sonoma State (No. 16), Pfeiffer (No. 18), North Dakota (No. 24) and Newberry (No. 25) moved into the top-25.
