***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FINAL
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE FALL SEASON**

Grand Valley State Replaces Nova Southeastern as Top Team in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The final *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the fall season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the November 30 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online at www.golfworld.com beginning December 2.

With four wins in six starts and two wins to close its fall schedule, Grand Valley State jumped from No. 3 to No. 1 in the final poll of the season. The Lakers have won nine of their last 12 tournaments dating back to last April.

Rounding out the top-five are Nova Southeastern (No. 2), Florida Southern (No. 3), Rollins (No. 4) and Indianapolis (No. 5).

Lynn University (No. 10) cracked the top-10, after being ranked No. 11 in the previous coaches' poll.

Grand Canyon (No. 22) moved into the top-25.
