JUDI PAVON NAMED NEW PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL GOLF COACHES ASSOCIATION

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (June 1, 2010) – Judi Pavon, University of Tennessee Women's Golf Coach, has been announced as the new President of the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). Pavon, most recently the association's Vice President, takes over for Rise Lakowske, Oregon State University Women's Golf Coach and NGCA President since 2008.

Pavon, who just completed her 10th season as head coach at Tennessee, has led the Big Orange to seven NCAA Championship appearances, including four straight berths from 2004-07. The Helena, Mont. native holds the UT coaching records for head-to-head wins (1,040) and tournament titles (11).
